CICO-SWIS provides school staff with easy and efficient online data for students on CICO by uploading daily CICO Point Cards. School staff can evaluate the overall effectiveness of CICO for a student and monitor a student's progress in their targeted intervention by viewing 5 different data reports in CICO-SWIS.
