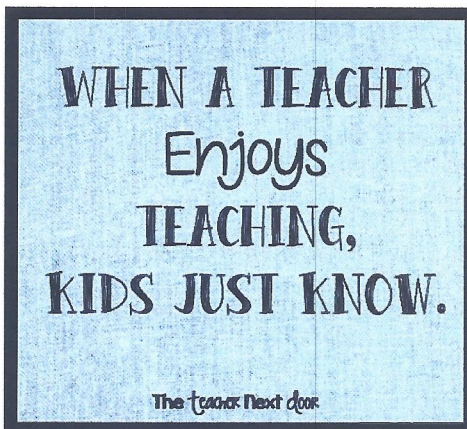

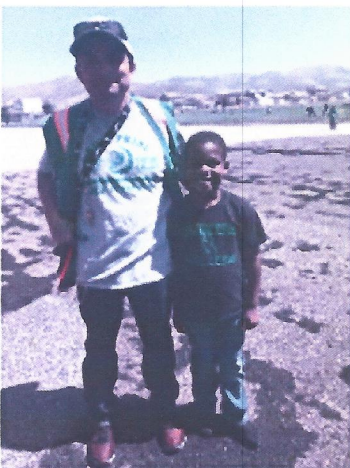
Great things I noticed last week:
