## LCAP Goal- Safety PBIS

Jack Francioni PBIS Teams met with the MCOE PBIS Consultant, Esther Rubio and completed the TFI Inventory to assess the current implementation of PBIS procedures and determine readiness to begin putting into place Tier III. Staff and students demonstrated high levels of implementation. We will attend a local "Reboot" review for Tiers I and II on September 25<sup>th</sup>.

76% of our classified and certificated staff and students correctly identified the schoolwide expectations and familiarity with the lion bucks and had used them within the week. Jack friend Joanie staff is conducting an on site reboot for classified staff to review the expectations and use of "Lion Bucks" to motivate prosocial behavior.

This week as temperatures soared, Jack students were offered an alternative place for recess. All are encouraged to drink plenty of water. RTI aides and campus supervisors assisted with providing breaks for her teachers.
